This bill classifies data on individuals collected for notification or informational purposes as private data. It includes the telephone number; personal e-mail address; and Internet user name and other online access information.

Minnesota Statutes, section 13.04, subdivision 2, would not apply to data classified under this section. This is the Tennessen warning, which requires government entities who collect private data from an individual to inform them of the purpose and intended use of the data, who may have access to it, etc.

An exception from the data classification is included for data submitted by an individual to the Campaign Finance Board to meet the legal requirements imposed by campaign finance and public disclosure laws.

An immediate effective date is included and the classification would apply to data collected, maintained, or received before, on, or after that date.
