CONSTITUTIONAL PRIVACY

- ONLY RELEVANT WHEN GOVERNMENT IS AN ACTOR

- FEDERAL IS SUBDIVIDED INTO:
 - FOURTH AMENDMENT PROTECTIONS AGAINST ILLEGAL "SEARCHES AND SEIZURES"

 - FAMILY MATTERS
 - "NEW" LAW
 - PROTECTION AGAINST GOVERNMENT INTRUSION INTO PERSONAL DECISIONS
 - CONTRACEPTION
 - ABORTION

-- FALSE LIGHT
