- 1.2 relating to state government; creating a Legislative Commission on Data
- 1.3 Practices and Personal Data Privacy; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
- 1.4 Statutes, chapter 3.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[3.8843] LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON DATA PRACTICES.**
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Established.** The Legislative Commission on Data Practices and
- 1.8 Personal Data Privacy is created to study issues relating to government data practices and
- 1.9 individuals' personal data privacy rights and to review legislation impacting data practices,
- 1.10 data security, and personal data privacy.
- 1.11 Subd. 2. **Membership.** The commission consists of seven senators appointed by the
- 1.12 senate Subcommittee on Committees of the Committee on Rules and Administration, and
- 1.13 seven members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker. No more than
- 1.14 four members from each chamber may be from the majority party in that chamber. Each
- 1.15 appointing authority must make appointments as soon as possible after the beginning of
- 1.16 the regular legislative session in the odd-numbered year.
- 1.17 Subd. 3. **Terms; vacancies.** Members of the commission serve for terms beginning
- 1.18 upon appointment and ending at the beginning of the regular legislative session in the next
- 1.19 odd-numbered year. The appropriate appointing authority must fill a vacancy for the
- 1.20 remainder of the unexpired term.
- 1.21 Subd. 4. **Officers.** The commission must elect a chair and may elect other officers
- 1.22 as it determines are necessary. The chair alternates between a member of the senate and a
- 1.23 member of the house of representatives in January of each odd-numbered year.
- 2.1 Subd. 5. **Staff.** Legislative staff must provide administrative and research assistance
- 2.2 to the commission.
- 2.3 Subd. 6. **Duties.** The commission shall:
- 2.4 (1) review and provide the legislature with research and analysis of emerging issues
- 2.5 relating to government data practices and security and privacy of personal data;
- 2.6 (2) review and make recommendations on legislative proposals relating to the
- 2.7 Minnesota Government Data Practices Act; and
- 2.8 (3) review and make recommendations on legislative proposals impacting personal
- 2.9 data privacy rights, data security, and other related issues.
- 2.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2014. Initial members of
- 2.11 the commission serve for a term ending in January 2015. A member of the house of
- 2.12 representatives shall serve as the first chair of the commission. A member of the senate
- 2.13 shall serve as chair of the commission beginning in January 2015.
