


**2014 Legislation**


- Requires the Commissioner of Public Safety to disclose data in bulk
- Permits the Commissioner to implement a driver records subscription service, including regular notice of records that have changed
- Requires the Commissioner to establish a bulk vehicle records fee


**2014 Legislation**

- Establishes a data security special revenue account and auditing requirements
- Requires the Legislative Commission on Data Practices to study issues relating to disclosure of driver and motor vehicle data in bulk form
- *This legislation is effective January 1, 2015*





**Subscription Service**



**Process**

- Subscription Service monitors the entire Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) database **daily** for changes to record information
- DVS will provide vendors with a **daily** transaction file with all of the records that have changed
  - Approximately 12,500-15,000 per day



**Fee**

- **Subscription Service Fee:** \$3,676.50/month
- **Subscription Service Record Fee:** \$0.01/record



## Current Status

- Seven companies received usernames and passwords and are involved in the testing process with DVS
- On track for full implementation January 1, 2015



## Motor Vehicle Records

- DVS will continue to provide bulk motor vehicle data records on a **monthly** basis
- Fee: \$0.01/record
